

So, you have decided or are thinking about the brave decision to go back to college to study for a nursing / midwifery degree as a mature student. That's fantastic!



What is a mature applicant?

If you are aged 23 years or over, you are classified as a mature applicant. Mature applicants can apply for nursing / midwifery degree courses through the CAO on www.cao.ie

Mature applicants will be considered on the basis of their performance in 'The Assessment Test', the results of which will be used in lieu of Leaving Certificate Exam (or equivalent) results. QQI FET/FETAC and/or Leaving Certificate, or other school leaving qualifications, can be considered if a candidate selects the relevant boxes in the Qualifications and Assessments section of the CAO Application Form.

Candidates must be successful in the Assessment Test to receive an offer. We realise that this application process can be very daunting, so we have designed this Free Guide to help guide you and hopefully answer any questions that you might have.



Step 1

Apply to CAO


The first step for mature applicants will be to apply to the CAO (Central Applications Office) on www.cao.ie for your university course. The CAO are the official body that process applications and provide information for filling out your CAO application form. See here for more:

Step 2

Apply to take the Assessment Test

Step 2: Using a valid CAO number, register with the NMBI on their website.

Details of this will be made available on the Nursing Midwifery Board Ireland <u>website</u>.



Step 3


Take the Assessment Test

The official Assessment test usually takes place mid - late April each year.

Candidates need to complete a suite of tests within the timeframe.

Applicants must be successful in the assessment tests to be considered for an offer as a mature applicant.

However, success in the test does not guarantee an offer of a place.

Usually a computer-based assessment that consists of three tests

Early June Results Released

Results released in early June with a breakdown of results / test scores and group position (order of merit place)

The Assessment Test

mature student nursing / midwifery assessment

Upon successfully applying for your 3rd level nursing course through the CAO website, you will be eligible to sit The Assessment Test for mature applicants. This test is usually a computer-based assessment and consists of three tests; a Verbal test, Numeracy test and Job Simulation Exercises. The Assessment Test is conducted by the Nursing Midwifery Board of Ireland.

In order to get an offer for your chosen nursing or midwifery degree course you must be successful in The Assessment Test. Information about the assessment test and familiarisation material is released each year closer to the official exam on www.nmbi.ie



Test 1 Verbal


This test is designed to measure a candidate's ability to understand and comprehend verbal information.





Test 2 Numerical


This test is designed to measure the ability of the candidate to carry out calculations on common day-to-day mathematical problems.





Test 3 Job Simulation Exercises

This exercise attempts to identify your likely response when presented with scenarios typical of what could occur in a job situation. This exercise measures a range of skills and qualities required in the Student Nurse role.
